A new colourful exhibition focusing on the impact of passenger railways on northeast life; particularly on the changes to work and leisure.

Celebrating the 200th anniversary of the first locomotive passenger train - a local invention that transformed the world - the importance and magnitude of the birth of the Stockton & Darlington Railway on the transport systems of the world cannot be measured.

Drawing on collections from The Story, visitors will have the chance to explore the remarkable changes brought by the railway system from the early 19th Century: industrial growth; work opportunities; seaside holidays; the war front; greater variety of goods in the shops; quicker information even the choice of a place to set up home.

All Change! aims to tell the story of how the railway redefined life for local people and communities; making travel faster, more comfortable, and accessible to a broader segment of the population.
