Mary Anderson's invention of the windshield wiper greatly enhanced safety by improving visibility in transportation vehicles.

Track Stability Innovation

Catherine Gibbon's Double Girder Lap-Joint Track reduced maintenance and increased track stability with fewer components.

Passenger Comfort Advances

Olive Dennis improved passenger experience by introducing reclining seats, air conditioning, and stain-resistant upholstery.

Challenges for Women in Rail/Transportation

Under representation & Attrition

Women make up only 23-26% of the rail workforce and c50% leave before age 34

Leadership roles disproportionally male; actively measure % females hire and promote

Structural Barriers

Removing gender stereotyping and unconscious bias - role models; stories; training and support

Create more flexible working, inclusive PPE, expanded facilities

Mental load and Wellbeing

Women often shoulder disproportionate domestic responsibilities affecting mental health and progression



Mentorship and Inclusion

Diversity in Perspectives

Unique experience of female rail passengers

Modal shift requires representative workforces to design networks that meet diverse needs

Innovation & Collaboration

Foster open communication, resilience, long term vision - key to technology, user centric transport systems and sustainability


